The intent is to, through a studentfaculty partnership, create a set of foundational/floor/baseline classroom management behaviors that align with the OEA contract.* It is expected that best practices in teaching be addressed through the TEACH principles. Classroom practices for instructors and students pertains to all undergraduate students and instructors. Instructors include full-time instructors, part-time instructors, graduate teaching assistants, and virtual assistants.
